To confirm minutes of the Special Meeting No. 01 of the Executive Committee held on 01-10-2022.

As no objection to the minutes of the meeting No. 01 of the Executive Committee held on 01-10-2022 was received, the same were confirmed by the Executive Committee and signed by Chairman in token of confirmation.

# ELECTION OF BROKERS ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE YEAR 2022-23

02. (a) To approve the draft program for holding election of the six licensed Cotton Brokers of The KCA on the Brokers Advisory Committee for the year 2022-23.

**RESOLUTION No. 12:** The Executive Committee approved the program for holding elections of the six licensed Cotton Brokers of the KCA on the Brokers Advisory Committee for the year 2022-23, according to which, ballot will be held on November 14, 2022 from 1200 hours to 1600 hours.

(b) To appoint two Scrutineers and Alternate Scrutineer for conducting election of the six licensed Cotton Brokers on the Brokers Advisory Committee for the year 2022-23.

**RESOLUTION No. 13:** The Executive Committee appointed Mr. Hassan Haider, Accounts Officer, Mr. Muhammad Tajdar Hussain, Senior Assistant as Scrutineers and Mr. Anis Akhtar Ghori, Accountant, Mr. Muhammad Haroon, Senior Office Assistant as Alternate Scrutineers for conducting elections of the six licensed Cotton Brokers on the Brokers Advisory Committee for the year 2022-23.

(c) To close the cotton market from 1200 hours to 1600 hours on 14-11-2022 to enable the Cotton Brokers to take part in the election of the Brokers Advisory Committee, if there are more candidates than the required number of seats under Rule 6 of the Cotton Brokers Licence Rules and the election is held.

**RESOLUTION No. 14:** The Executive Committee decided that the Cotton Market will remain closed from 1200 hours to 1600 hours on 14-11-2022 to enable the Cotton Brokers to take part in the elections of the Brokers Advisory Committee.

Chairman informed the Executive Committee that the ICA in collaboration with the KCA organized the above referred Training Workshops at Karachi and Lahore which were attending by large number of participants from different sectors of the Cotton Trade. He said that Mr. Muhammad Ali, Deputy Secretary (Statistics) did a good job in organizing these Workshops in a good manners.

Mr. Waqas Anwar, while appreciating the initiative, stated that no preliminary information relating to the above referred Workshops were given to the Members / Cotton Trade. He suggested that number of participation should be increased and more publicity be made towards such event in future.

Chairman stated that there was good turnout of the participants in the Workshops against the expectation and therefore, the arrangements of the events were reorganized at last time. Replying to a query, Chairman also stated that the participation of Pakistan in ICA's Committees were more than other countries.

# NOMINATION ON THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE KARACHI COTTON ASSOCIATION

09. Letter dated 18-10-20222 received from the Finance Division (External Finance Wing), Government of Pakistan, Islamabad informing that Mr. Shahid Raza, Deputy Secretary EF (Budget) has been nominated as Member on the Executive Committee of the KCA for the year 2022-23 for information.

Chairman informed the Executive Committee that the Finance Division (External Finance Wing), Government of Pakistan, Islamabad, vide their letter dated 18-10-2022 had informed that Mr. Shahid Raza, Deputy Secretary, EF (Budget) had been nominated as representative of Finance Division (External Finance Wing), Government of Pakistan on the Executive Committee of the KCA for the year 2022-23.

# 10. SETTING-UP OF 160KWp ON GRID SOLAR PV SYSTEM WITH NET METERING AT THE ROOF OF THE COTTON EXCHANGE BUILDING.

Chairman recalled the Executive Committee that in pursuance of E.C. Resolution No. 128 dated 24-09-2020, a MOU / Agreement for setting-up 160KWp On-Grid Solar PV System with Net metering on the Roof of the Cotton Exchange was signed by the KCA with M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd. on 31-08-2022 and 10% advance payment of Rs. 1,955,733/-, out of total amount of Rs. 19,557,326/- was paid to M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd at the time of signing of MOU / Agreement.

He informed the Executive Committee that the materials of the above referred project would be delivered to the KCA by M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin Company Limited) in the coming days and that time the KCA would be required to pay 60% payment to M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd.

He also informed the Executive Committee that after making 60% payment to M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd at the time of delivery of materials, the KCA would also be required to pay 20% payment after complete installation and commissioning of the project and 10% payment after Net Metering.

**RESOLUTION No. 22:** After consideration, the Executive Committee approved to make all payments relating to the above referred project to M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd as per payment terms contained in the MOU / Agreement signed between the KCA and M/s. Zonergy (Tianjin) Company Ltd on 31-08-2022.
